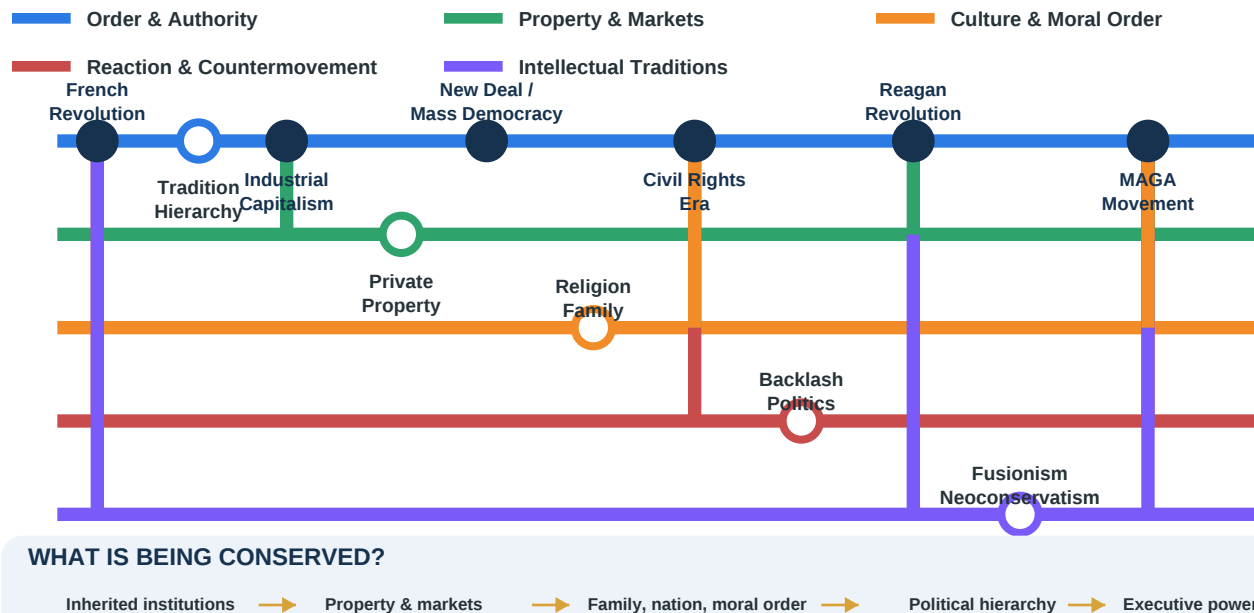


CONSERVATIVE THOUGHT: A HISTORICAL OVERVIEW

CONTEMPORARY DEBATE

Scholars describe the MAGA movement using terms including right-wing populism, national conservatism, competitive authoritarianism, and, in some analyses, fascism or neo-fascism. The dispute turns on political violence, executive power, pluralism, and the weakening of democratic constraints.

THREE RESPONSES TO DEMOCRATIC CRISIS

Conservative reform

Preserve institutions while adapting them.

Reactionary politics

Restore an earlier social and political order.

Authoritarian politics

Concentrate power while weakening democratic constraints.

QUESTIONS FOR DEMOCRATIC INQUIRY

- What has conservatism sought to preserve - and why?
- When does order strengthen democracy?
- When does reaction become authoritarian?
- How should democracy engage its principal rival critically?
